2024 High School Job Shadow Information Sheet

Program Description: The High School Job Shadow program offers students a front-row seat to the prosecutor's role in the criminal justice system. Students who demonstrate a strong interest in a career in criminal justice are selected to participate in the program. The experience allows students the opportunity to shadow a variety of professionals and learn about topics ranging from Criminal Justice 101 to white-collar crime to human trafficking. They also observe court proceedings, including trials. An exciting incentive for students of the program is one-on-one time with prosecutors to discuss what they observed in the courtroom.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must reside in Knox County
- Applicants must be sophomores, juniors or seniors in high school at the time they apply
- Applicants must commit to attend the entire program from June 4-8, 2024, Monday through Friday from 8:30am – 3:00 pm.

Requirements:

- Completed and signed application form
- Letter of recommendation from an adult, other than a family member
- Background check (*to be completed by the Office of the District Attorney General*)
